## **Next Steps**

- Screener for referral
  - Navigators will be conducting a screening with families prior to referring Tier 3 services.
- Protocol for referral
  - Will have to collect data in several federal projects for Tier 3 supports and services.
    - i. This includes screening and therapy notes.
  - Develop guidelines and templates for those who creating or strengthen their current referral protocol.

- Bounce-Back and CBITS training
  - Content is very similar to that of SSET; however, this certification allows for 1 on 1 therapy sessions.
    - Bounce Back is for elementary kiddos.
    - CBITS is for middle schools' kiddos
  - Allows for clinical setting based on the kiddos needs.
  - Available for LMHP staff
- Tier 3 support
  - Last dollar therapy services for short term trauma therapy sessions. The grant will fund the last dollars for 6-8 weeks of sessions.
  - After the 6-8 weeks, the team at the school will determine if they will continue to fund the therapy session or if it is up to the family.

## **Updates & Questions:**

- Can send referrals now for Tier 3 services.
- SSET/CBITS/Bounce Back are not Behavior groups these are for those kiddos that are struggling with a trauma.
- **NBC**: The quarantine has been causing impacts on students that are not able to have the social/life experiences. Contact tracing has caused concerns with students and their friendships.
- **Fremont**: experience same trauma as NBC but also students whose parents that have lost employment because of COVID-19.
- PSA (short 5-10 minutes) be created by mental health staff to share with districts.
- Social Dilemma is a must watch on Netflix.
  - The Social Dilemma focuses on how big social media companies manipulate users by using algorithms that encourage addiction to their platforms. It also shows, fairly accurately, how platforms harvest personal data to target users with ads – and have so far gone largely unregulated.
